**The Leadership Academy** is an executive leadership program consisting of six two-day sessions over ten months. You will join an experienced group of local government officials and top administrative staff who will examine leadership styles, principles, and responsibilities relevant to your public leadership role.

**The Curriculum** prepares participants for the challenges of leading dynamic organizations in the public sector. New ideas and models are explored with your fellow classmates and expert faculty to develop a set of successful leadership perspectives to improve the performance of your organization. You will learn by sharing insights and experiences with your colleagues as you become part of a mutually supportive team.

**A Recognition Ceremony** will honor those who have successfully completed the program. A University of Illinois certificate will be presented to Leadership Academy graduates.
